We've been meeting in person for two weeks now and it's been great to be back! As we continue to move forward through this pandemic and assess the needs of our church family, we have decided to make some adjustments and open up more of our ministries within the church. We feel this is a sustainable plan for the summer months. If things change we will be sure to keep everyone updated. We thank you for your patience, grace and understanding as we work through this together.

### Starting Sunday, July 5

For the remaining two Sundays in June, we will continue our current service schedule.

Starting the first Sunday in July, services will be live-streamed on Facebook and YouTube at 10:30 each Sunday morning. In addition, we'll also be offering two services in the sanctuary, 9:00 & 10:30. Both services will be multi-generational and open to everyone. We encourage those with a high risk for complications with COVID-19 to attend the 9:00 a.m. service. Face coverings are not required for either service but are recommended for our 9:00 a.m. (high-risk) service. We will continue to practice physical distancing and follow other CDC guidelines that help keep our church family safe.

What you can expect when coming to church....

- **Non-contact Greeting** - you can expect a wave rather than a handshake from our greeters. Bulletins can be found at the welcome center.
- **Hand Sanitizer Stations** - you will see hand sanitizer in several areas of the building for you to use as needed.
- **Seating** - The sanctuary will have certain pews and areas marked off to help with physical distancing. To limit contact with surfaces, the marked off seating will be different for each of the services. We will have ushers to help you find the best seating option.
- **Dismissal** - We'll have ushers dismiss each service by pew/table. We ask that you not gather in common areas.
- **Offering** - We will not be passing offering plates during the church service. There is a basket in the foyer that you can place your offering. Online giving is still available and you can always mail your tithes & offerings to PO Box 85, Churubusco, IN 46723.
